3 Overview

Your high performance **VP-4** *1:4 VGA Distributor* is a 1:4 distribution amplifier for VGA signals. In particular, the **VP-4** *1:4 VGA Distributor*:

• Accepts a single VGA/SVGA/XGA input source and distributes it to 4 identical outputs using female 15pin HD connectors

• Includes an input and outputs that are DC coupled and provides buffering and isolation that conform to the highest standards

• With its video bandwidth of 350 MHz, ensures transparent operation even at high resolution VGA modes

Achieving the best performance means:

• Connecting only good quality connection cables, thus avoiding interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)

• Avoiding interference from neighboring electrical appliances that may adversely influence signal quality and positioning your Kramer **VP-4** in a location free from moisture and away from excessive sunlight and dust




Figure 1: VP-4 1:4 VGA Distributor
